

Young Reading Series Two

Series Two titles are for children who are reading more confidently, and are 64 pages (2,000-2,500 words) in length. They use varied sentence lengths, more complex sentence structure and more challenging vocabulary.

Most Series Two books contain a single narrative divided into chapters. Subjects include classic tales and myths, mystery stories and non-fiction.
